

# WordCruncher: iOS version


When you run WordCruncher the first time on your iPhone or iPad, you will see some Startup Guides that briefly explain the basics features. Then you will go to the Bookstore to download books.

## Download and Open Books

<p><b>Bookstore</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Tap the menu icon to filter the list, switch collections or libraries, or use a WordCruncher ID. The ID is required to buy a book and install it on up to 10 devices.</li> <li>2. Tap on the Library option to see books in that library or collection. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The WordCruncher Library has books published by BYU and other publishers. The LDS Gospel Library includes material found on <a href="http://www.lds.org">www.lds.org</a>.</li> </ul> </li> <li>3. The world icon indicates a book that you can download in multiple languages.</li> </ol>	
<p>The bottom buttons let you see:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Your <b>Library</b> of downloaded books you can open.</li> <li>• The <b>Bookstore</b> so you can <i>download</i> or <i>open</i> books.</li> <li>• Your <b>Purchases</b> so you can see, open, or update books</li> <li>• The <b>Search</b> tab to find books to download or open.</li> <li>• The <b>Information</b> tab to find the license, version, etc.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Download a Book</b></p> <p>After taping on a book, you will see:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a brief description of the book, and</li> <li>• a download link so see the available modules you can download.</li> <li>• The world icon, if present, indicates you can download the book in other languages.</li> </ul> <p>If multiple modules are available, you can tap the install all link, or download individual modules.</p>	
<p><b>Open a Book</b></p> <p>Tap on Library, Bookstore, Purchases, or Search to find a book to open, and tap on Open.</p>	

## Text Window

1. Tap the menu icon to open another book, switch books, or change view settings.
2. Tap on the citation bar to jump to another location in the book.
3. See a dictionary definition, tags, or your notes. If you download Webster's 1844 dictionary, you can tap an English word and then tap this dictionary icon to see the definition.
4. Tap on the right side to see options to move to a nearby location
5. Tap on a link to jump to another location.




The bottom buttons let you:


- Go to the previous or next location after tapping a link.
- Search for words.
- Set a Bookmark
- Go to the Library to download or open a book.

Tap the Menu icon to:

- open another book,
- switch to an open book, and
- change view settings (font size, night mode, margins).




Note: Version 1.3 will let you open another book in a new page or in the same page with another book to see both side by side.



## Searching


1. Tap the menu button to see search options (see below).
2. Type words and logic as in the desktop version.
3. Tap the view icon to see more context.  
You can also double tap in the text area.



The bottom buttons let you see or select one of three search lists.


## Search Options

- You can cancel a search.
- You can change search and view settings.
- You can change search options.



## Navigation and Frequency Distribution

- Tap on the frequency button.
- Tap on the Options link to see more options.
- Tap on a book or chapter to jump to the first search hit in that book or chapter.



## Dictionary Window

- See a dictionary definition, tags, or your notes.  
If you download Webster's 1844 dictionary, you can tap an English word and then tap this dictionary icon to see the definition.
- Tap the switch icon to use a different dictionary.
- You will see:
  - Word you tapped.
  - Entries containing that word,
  - Definitions of the word.
- Swipe right in the dictionary to close the window

Note: If you download the LDS Scriptures, you can look up Hebrew or Greek Bible words.

The bottom buttons let you see the:

- Dictionary information.
- Notes you have made
- Tags included in the book.



## English Parallel Bible


The English Parallel Bible is a module that you can download when you download the LDS Scriptures.

Tap English Parallel Bible to see transliterated Hebrew or Greek words ('ēlōhīm or Christós). Tap Advanced to see Hebrew or Greek words (אֱלֹהִים or Χριστός).

Drag the Footnotes header up or down to change the size of the pane.



1. Tap on the citation bar to jump to another location in the book.
2. Tap on a link to jump to another location.
3. Tap on the Search icon to search for words.




This is the start of Genesis 1:1.

The left column contains Hebrew or Greek words written with English letters.

The right column contains the KJV translation with English words reordered to correspond to the Hebrew or Greek word order.

HEB notes come from the LDS Footnotes.



Tap on a Hebrew or Greek word and then the Dictionary icon to see a brief definition.
