





# How to Get the English Parallel Bible and the Dead Sea Scrolls

**Install WordCruncher:** WordCruncher is available for Windows computers. For instructions and helps, go to [wordcruncher.com/docs/getting-started](http://wordcruncher.com/docs/getting-started).

<p>Download the Scriptures</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Select WordCruncher Bookstore from the File menu.</li><li>2. Select Gospel Library Collection</li></ol>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>3. Click on FREE to download the Scriptures, or Open if you have downloaded it. Click on “Other languages...” to download the Scriptures in other languages.</li></ol>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>4. Click on the Install button on the line for each of the following modules:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. Scriptures and Study Helps,</li><li>b. English Parallel Bible (English letters), and</li><li>c. English Parallel Bible – Advanced (Hebrew and Greek letters).</li></ol>The Open button will appear in the top right corner after the file is installed.</li><li>5. Click on Open to open the Scriptures.</li></ol>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>6. Click on Advanced to open the Advanced Parallel Bible.  Click on “English Parallel Bible” to see the basic version.</li></ol>	

<p>7. Click on Hebrew Old Testament.</p> <p>For tips, click on the “How to Use This Books link.”</p> <p>8. Click on Genesis.</p>	
<p>The English scriptures will also be at Genesis 1:1.</p> <p>Size and position both windows to see one under the other.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> The English word order matches the Hebrew and Greek word order.</p> <p><b>Feedback:</b> Students decided which KJV English words to put to the right of Hebrew word. If you notice mistakes, send your suggested corrections to <a href="mailto:mfshelley@live.com">mfshelley@live.com</a>.</p>	
<p>9. Click on the Parallel Bible window and select Options from the Book menu.</p> <p>Click Word Separators to show or hide small red slashes that separate prefixes and suffixes as shown above.</p>	
<p>10. <b>Dictionary:</b> To open the dictionary window, click on the dictionary icon.</p> <p><i>Mean</i> is a brief definition.</p> <p><i>KJV</i> shows how the word was translated in the KJV Bible.</p> <p>To see a longer definition, click on the top link (h1284).</p> <p><i>Word Forms</i> shows part of speech info.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> If you download Webster’s 1844 American Dictionary of the English Language, you can click on English words to see an 1844 definition.</p>	
<p>11. <b>Dead Sea Scroll collection:</b> To install or open the DSS, select WordCruncher Bookstore from the File menu. The red ovals show the settings.</p> <p>Click on FREE or Open. (<i>Note: It is free to BYU students and faculty on campus.</i>)</p>	
<p>12. On the DSS title page, click on <i>Hebrew Scripture</i> to see the Hebrew Bible with part of speech info for each word.</p> <p>Click on <i>English Translations</i> to see the Dead Sea Scrolls Bible.</p>	

**Note:** BYU faculty and students in Donald Parry’s Hebrew class can get access to restricted Bible translations. Go to the WordCruncher Bookstore and click on the Account tab.
